2010 CCM Preparatory Department Junior Piano Concerto Festival

Saturday, February 27, 2010

Robert J. Werner Recital Hall at University of Cincinnati

There will be two events in the 2010 Junior Piano Concerto Festival. The **Concerto Achievement Evaluation** is an evaluation event with no judging and the **Concerto Competition** is for students who wish to participate in a judged competition. Both events are presented in recital format.

Application Due: A completed **Application and Payment** must be submitted to **Piano Concerto Festival** with a postmark on or before **Saturday, December 12, 2009**.

Application Fees: **Concerto Achievement Evaluation:**
\$30/mvt (CCM Prep./OMTA student); \$35/mvt (Non Prep/OMTA);
Additional \$10 for 1 additional mvt or \$15 for 2 additional mvts
Concerto Competition:
\$35/mvt CCM Prep./OMTA student); \$40/mvt (Non Prep/OMTA);
Additional \$10 for 1 additional mvt or \$15 for 2 additional mvts

FESTIVAL CATEGORIES

A student can only participate in one of these events. It is highly recommended that the teacher and student determine the most appropriate area for the student.

★ Concerto Achievement Evaluation

The **Concerto Achievement Evaluation** is for students who wish to have an evaluation of their playing by the judges, but students are not placed and do not compete with each other. This is suggested for students who are participating in an event like this for the first time, or for students who prefer a non-competitive environment. This category is **open to any student** who has not reached their 15th birthday by the date of the event, February 27, 2010. Participants may perform any of the listed repertoire on the next page. Each performer will receive a certificate along with constructive comments by the judges. Students who perform the entire concerto (all movements) will receive a **Complete Concerto Award**.

Important information for the Concerto Achievement Evaluation:

- Participants must **not** have reached their **15th birthday** by **February 27, 2010**.
- Applicants who wish to perform concerti not on the approved **Repertoire Lists** must contact the concerto committee by December 1, 2009 for permission.
- All performances must be from **memory**.
- **Performances must be accompanied. All contestants are responsible for securing the services of their accompanists. CCM Preparatory is not responsible to provide accompanists.**
- The event will run in a recital format. The event allows video recording and applause for each performance. No flash photography is allowed.
- The participants must provide one original score of the work they will perform for the judges. **All measures must be numbered.**
- The confirmation and final schedule of the event will be sent to participating teachers electronically on **February 1, 2010**. Teachers will communicate the performance times to their students.
- Contestants are encouraged to invite family and friends to hear their performances. The audience is expected to arrive before the beginning of each division concert and remain for its entirety.

★ Concerto Competition

The **Concerto Competition** is divided into three divisions. The level of the complexity increases successively in each division. Contestants may perform a movement(s) from the approved list of works for each division. See the **Repertoire Lists** for the approved works. Contestants will compete separately in 1st, 2nd, and 3rd movement categories. Contestants may enter more than one movement. In case of low enrollment, movements within the division may be combined. Students who perform the entire concerto (all movements) will receive a **Complete Concerto Award**.

Division I - must not have reached their 10th birthday by February 27, 2010

Division II - must not have reached their 13th birthday by February 27, 2010

Division III - must not have reached their 15th birthday by February 27, 2010

Preparation for the Competition:

- Applicants who wish to perform concerti not on the approved **Repertoire Lists** must contact the concerto committee by December 1, 2009 for permission.
- All performances must be from **memory**.
- **Performances must be accompanied. All contestants are responsible for securing the services of their accompanists. CCM Preparatory is not responsible to provide accompanists.**
- All Divisions will run in a recital format. The competition allows video recording and applause for each performance. No flash photography is allowed.

Competition Policies and Procedures:

- The contestants must provide one original score of the work they will perform for the judges. All measures must be numbered.
- Contestants are encouraged to invite family and friends to hear their performances. The audience is expected to arrive before the beginning of each division concert and remain for its entirety.
- An **Award Ceremony** will follow the competition in Robert J. Werner Recital Hall on February 27, 2010. The judges have the option to award first, second, third prizes and award Honorable Mention for each competition category when appropriate.
- The confirmation and final schedule of the festival and award ceremony will be sent to participating teachers electronically on February 1, 2010. Teachers will communicate the competition times to their students.
