Debussy – Afternoon of a Faun; Brahms / Symphony #4; Mendelssohn / Midsummer Night's Dream

Audition materials will be drawn from the pieces listed below. This list highlights some of the significant works being programmed this coming academic year at CCM. Most of these materials are available from Orchestra Musician's CD-ROM Library (our preferred choice), or can be found in excerpt form in either the Vade-Mecum and Rothwell set; or whole parts may be ordered through Kalmus or Gail Warnaar Double Reeds. Specific passages for the audition will be taken only from the Oboe 1 parts (no English horn) and will be sent via .pdf files later during the summer.

JAZZ ENSEMBLES AND COMBOS: Students with jazz experience should be prepared to sight-read and to improvise on a tune of their choice. Also, a jazz etude, ensemble passage or improvisation on an additional tune are optional if time permits. Rhythm section instrumentalists may be asked to play tunes with various time feels in addition to the above. Students with little or no jazz experience are also encouraged to audition and may perform part of a classical solo and sight-reading. Saxophonists who double should perform scales on flute and clarinet. This audition will also serve as the Diagnostic Board for new Jazz Studies Majors (freshmen and transfers).
